

## Miami & Linn County Kansas Barn Quilt Trail Application

It's time to gather names and locations of the many barn quilts that are displayed in Miami and/or Linn County Kansas. The current trail was started in Feb. 2018 and it's time to add to the trail!

To be included in the published listing of the barn quilt blocks, **please complete the application – found on Page 2**. Please provide as much detail as possible. For instance, you may not know the formal name of the quilt block or the artist. Simply provide the details you can confirm.

A committee will review applications and you will be notified if further information is needed to place your barn quilt on the local quilt trail. Our goal is to expand and add to the existing map including information and a picture of the barn quilt that has been hung and submitted to be a part of the trail. Target due date for applications is January 15, 2020.

(Note: If you currently have a barn quilt on the Miami or Linn County Kansas Barn Quilt Trail, <u>you do not need to submit another application</u>. Our goal is only to add <u>new</u> barn quilts to the existing trail.)

**History-** The following information is for promotional use only of the **MIAMI & LINN County Kansas Barn Quilt Trail** and not essential for listing on the trail. Please limit information to no more than 250 words. Suggestions of things to include: Send on e-mail or print below.

- How long has the farm (or property) been in the current family? When was the building built?
- What was the building's original function? What is the building used for now?
- What is the material the building is made of?
- Please share any interesting stories about the building, farm, area or family.
- Why was this guilt pattern chosen? Does it have special significance for the family or area?

**\*Optional Description:** A summary of what you would like printed on the trail directory is limited to 40 words. We will write this for you unless you submit it below: Here is an example:

This 4' x 4 'barn quilt block was selected from a wedding quilt received by the couple 40 years ago. Painted as a Christmas gift for his wife, it's located on an 1800's era barn. (Short & concise)
